



The Gunnerus Award in Sustainability Science 2019

Call for nominations

The Norwegian University of Science and Technology (NTNU) and the Royal Norwegian Society of Sciences and Letters calls for nominations of candidates for the Gunnerus Award in Sustainability Science 2019.

The award honors outstanding scientific work promoting global sustainable development. The aim is to contribute to the strengthening of research and advancing the achievement of the scientific evidence base within the interdisciplinary Sustainability Science.

The Gunnerus Award in Sustainability Science amounts to NOK 1 million.

The Gunnerus Award is presented to a scholar who has made outstanding contributions to sustainability science within the fields of the natural sciences, social sciences, humanities or technological sciences, either through interdisciplinary work or through work within one of these fields. The Gunnerus Award is awarded to one scientist, or may be shared between two scientists, in the case of closely related fundamental scientific contributions.

The conferring institutions invite nominations from scientific academies, research institutions, universities and full professors to ensure a balanced invitation of natural, social, technological and human sciences. Self-nominations are not accepted. The Gunnerus Scientific Committee receives all nominations and may itself nominate candidates.
